Job Summary

We are looking to strengthen our Business Coordination Team with a new position, i.e. **Business Analysis & Chartering**. The primary role of this new position is threefold :

1. On the technical side : to organize data into easy to visualize and read information, to develop and enhance reports using data collection, data management, data visualization and reporting techniques to support analysis and decision making. The analyst must be able to think critically and tackle complex requests. Successful candidates will have a strong experience with relational databases and the ability to understand business requirements and work with stakeholders to develop automated reporting solutions.
2. On the analysis side : to assist Management and other divisions in the PDCA process, thoroughly use the acquired understanding of data through the above, in making recommendations for improving the overall well-being of the Company, as well as participating in Budget process, Strategy papers, and alike.
3. On the chartering side : to negotiate and execute Charter Parties with Owners, Charterers or Brokers through the acquired understanding of supply/demand analyses, to report internally and follow up the post-fixture operation/administration.

This role is ideal for an individual who has a passion for using data to drive decision making in a corporate environment and is comfortable working autonomously and professionally to meet deadlines. This is a highly visible position that will interact with people in diverse countries and cultures, along with exposure to senior leadership.



Primary Duties and Responsibilities

As a Business Analyst & Charterer you will become part of EML's Business Coordination Team which is responsible for corporate planning, strategic pricing, tender studies, supply/demand analyses for the commodity we ship and for the ships themselves, operational reporting and budgeting, chartering vessels in/out, and business intelligence. The Business Analyst would be responsible for sourcing and developing reporting solutions to help improve decisions for the organization, design and produce user-friendly intelligence reporting, business metrics, reports, dashboards and data solutions, which is to be used to make concrete recommendations to Management and other divisions, as well as to be used in Budget/Strategy planning.

The Charterer would be responsible to acquire thorough understanding of the market and its players, build relationship with Owners, Operators, Brokers, and other stakeholders, and will negotiate and execute relevant Charter Parties, including post-fixture management.
